- Check all boxes are unsealed
- Review contents of boxes and ensure any Non-Fairy Friendly restricted items are removed (see below for list)
- Ensure boxes are labelled with the demographic of the intended recipient (e.g. Golden Box for Female)
- Ensure £1 donation is Cellotaped to the inside of the box lid
- Please complete the Christmas Box Crib Sheet with the number of boxes received and their intended lucky recipients

Non-Fairy Friendly (Restricted) Items

Please do not include any of the following in your Shoebox donations

- Unsealed or perishable food items
- Inflammable liquids
- Alcohol
- Matches
- Batteries
- Money
